# 3. Appointment of Internal Auditor

The Internal Auditor for last year and since 2021, was appointed through NCALC, It is proposed that the same person be appointed as Internal Auditor for the coming year. The appointment will need to be routed through NCALC under the terms of their agreement both with us and with the person appointed, The cost in 2024/5 has been estimated at £1000

It is possible to source an auditor independently but it is likely to be more costly and furthermore, some continuity of audit will be helpful in the coming year.

**RECOMMENDED** that Kate Houlihan be re-appointed as internal auditor for the 24/25 financial year.

# 4. Banking Arrangements

The Council's primary bank account is with Unity Trust Bank. A further account with Unity Trust Bank exists to accommodate receipts and payments from the community lottery and two interest bearing savings accounts are maintained for the general reserve and an election reserve.

A further bank account is held with Lloyds bank in which to place the monies raised by the Mayor during their term of office for charitable purposes

Members are also asked to note the retention of bank accounts to manage the William Martin Charity and the Kettering Charities for the Poor, which were in place previously and which are separately audited and managed, under the auspices of the Trustees. One of these three accounts has been moved from Barclays to Lloyds bank.

# 5. Asset Register

Members are asked to **note** the asset register as at 1<sup>st</sup> April 2024, as set out below. Values have now been placed on four of the allotments sites, for the purposes of registration with the Land Registry, with the fifth site – Whiteford Drive – awaiting valuation once a lacuna in the title boundary has been resolved.
