2023/024      Threatened Closure of Kettering Conference Centre

To consider the following motion, proposed by Cllr Mitchell and seconded by Cllr Pandey

“Kettering Town Council is concerned at the potential closure of Kettering Conference Centre shortly. It strongly believes that the best chance for the centre to flourish in the future is to avoid even a temporary closure now. There is an urgent need to find a consortium of interested parties who can pick up and manage the centre and the organisation best placed to convene such a consortium is NNC, which retains a strong interest in the provision of sport, leisure, economic development and the overall welfare of Kettering, of which this building is an important feature. KTC urges NNC and other parties to work closely together to find a workable solution before the building is shut”
