1. Purpose of Report

To seek approval for repairs to be carried out to the pedestrian bridge at South End Allotments

2. Recommendations

That the quotation of £2192 from Make Woodworking be accepted to carry out repairs to the bridge at South End Allotments.

3. Information

- 3.1. Following a decision at the February meeting of this committee, three companies were asked to quote for repairs to the bridge which connects two parts of the South End Allotments.
- 3.2 Only one company was able to submit a quote and it is summarised below.

Remove and replace damaged timbers -replace with treated	£1032
timbers, include a new handrail fence along the bank side All	
fixings to be exterior grade. Vertical slats to be supplied on	
both sides of the bridge	
Bridge to be painted with a dark brown weatherproof	£350
treatment. Timber to be prepared – rot hardener to be	
applied on existing timbers that are still usable but showing	
signs of age	

Pressure washing using fungicide. Water supplied in transportable tanks due to lack of water supply on site	£200
Install 2m long anti-slip strips across each plank o The hard anti slip strips are glued and screwed to the timber deck and are low maintenance and easily replaceable. The strips are 3mm thick fibreglass can withstand high footfall traffic	£360
Provisional: Replace and repair any damaged timbers not visible upon survey o This provisional allowance will cover the replacement of any unforeseen damaged timbers. The actual cost will be calculated at the end of the job	£250
TOTAL Excl VAT	£2192

4. Consultation and Engagement

4.1. The views of the allotment association have been sought throughout.

5. Finance, Legal and Resource Implications

- 5.1 There is a net £4000 in the budget for allotments, which is likely to be supplemented by further income during the course of this year, together with the rents due, so, in total, there is up to approximately £7500 available to spend.
- 5.2. It would be possible to seek further quotes from other companies, but given the relatively modest cost of the work and the need to make the bridge safer than it is, it is recommended that we proceed with this quote as representing good value.

6. Policy Implications

The Council has a responsibility keep its assets in good working order and to ensure the health and safety of users of the allotments.
