FC22/081	Registration of Allotments with Land Registry
	A report was presented which sought authority to employ solicitors to ensure the registration of the Council's allotment land. NNC had prepared the title documents and included the additional parcels of land at South End Allotments.  Willson Browne Solicitors were already engaged by the Council to complete an easement over the Northfield Avenue allotments in favour of WPD and it was

FC22/082	Windmill Avenue Allotments Fencing Renewal
	A report was submitted seeking approval to award a contract for the renewal of fencing at Windmill Avenue allotments. The committee at its meeting on 25 <sup>th</sup> January had agreed to seek quotes for the work, and the only company to quote, of those approached, had quoted £14139.50.
	Mr Thurland of Kettering Allotment Society expressed the society's support for this investment and their appreciation of the work the Town Council was doing to support allotments.

	A report was submitted summarising current activity, and referenced a Carbon Literacy Toolkit developed by the Society of Local Council Clerks and the Carbon Literacy Project.

FC22/084	Community Resilience Fund
	A report was submitted which sought approval to award a grant to North Northants Sports and Wellbeing Club in order for them to provide a Womens Safe Workshop in the Avondale Grange area. Workshops were designed to improve the confidence of women to leave their homes by themselves. This project had not succeeded in being funded through the NNC's Community budgeting round which had bene voted on in February by local people, but was nevertheless felt to be a project which met the Council's objectives and budget and was capable of being delivered in the near future. The Council had set aside £1000 from its community resilience

budget to support projects on the Avondale Grange estate, in order to supplement the levelling up funding already earmarked for the area.

**RESOLVED** that a grant of £1000 be made from the Community Resilience Fund to North Northants Sports and Wellbeing Club for them to provide a Womens Safe Workshop in the Avondale Grange area.
