General update of planned events –

The current timetable for the market place in 2022 is:

- June – Vegan Market 4th June,
- July – Teenage Market (as part of KettFest), 30th July Street Food Saturday
- August – 27th Street Food Saturday
- September – 24th Street Food Saturday
- October –
- November – 13th Remembrance Day Parade
- December -

Update and General discussion –

Food and Drink Festival took place on 9th April, we are awaiting feedback from LSD but general feedback received had been positive and the event was busy on the day.

General Market - Consultation completed, now plan needs to be presented to council for agreement. Alex has completed further consultation with existing stall holders and feedback will be included in the report to full council. Plan to be proposed to full council to re-start charges from 8th June 2022, to keep the market 3 days per week, to remain in the current location and review this in 3 months and remove the specific denomination days so anyone can attend any market day.

Vegan Market –

KTC still needs to be added as a co-host for social media sharing. Emil has approached some plant traders who have expressed an interest in holding a stall. The organiser of KettFest has agreed

that we can use their tables from the Church Rooms (adjacent to the Market Place). Emily to speak to Church Rooms to see if they may be willing to open their toilets for the event. Shire Sounds have been booked for the event and will be complemented by a variety of local buskers.

Street Food Saturdays –

5 vendors planned, KTC to charge usual rate for stall hire and Dom (from Street Food) to charge his fee in addition. Temporary events license has been applied for. Agreed that the event on 30th July will be supported by KTC with Shire Sounds music and a collection of musicians sourced by Stevie Sounds (who arranged musicians for the Food and Drink Festival). This event theme will be fun and games, including a 'flash mob'. Event on 27th August to be themed as a community cultural event and 24th September to be themed around the Arts.

Teen Market / Farmers Market /

The first Teen market of the year will take place during the KettFest on 2nd July. Local farmers market stall holders to be approached to hold at stall at a farmers' market on 30th July, to be sited with general market stalls.

Agreed actions –

Emily to liaise with Vegan Market to check how they want to manage additional commercial stall holders

Emily to speak to Church Rooms to see if they may be willing to open their toilets for the event.

Martin to purchase some table cloths for the Vegan Market tables

Craig/Martin to contact potential farmers market stall holders to invite them to hold a stall on 30th July.

Alex to share consultation feedback with Martin for inclusion in report to full council.
