ME23/39	Events Schedule 2023/4 Progress report					
	A report was submitted on the events programme to date, primarily updating on the cost profile. The likely spend for the year was £120,350, compared to a budget of £120,000. Whilst Christmas events had overspent, this had been balanced by savings on Kettering by the Sea and other events. RESOLVED that the report be noted.					
ME23/40	Remembrance Day 2024					
	The clerk reported on the outcome of a meeting with the Royal British Legion, which had taken place recently. Revised arrangements for Remembrance Sunday had been discussed alongside other initiatives being planned by the RBL.					
	Members endorsed the proposal that the Remembrance Sunday parade should be formed up at the top of Gold St, and proceed to the Market Place where the ceremony of remembrance would take place around a drumhead formed					

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	there, rather than at the war memorial. Wreaths would then be relocated to the war memorial.
	 The RBL would conduct a service of remembrance in the London Rd cemetery on the 80th anniversary of D day That Armed Forces day would be a component part of the June Summer Saturday That Armistice Day would be marked by a small service on the 11th November at the war memorial That discussions had begun with NNC about the potential transfer of ownership of the war memorial to the Town Council and that, if these proceeded, a report would be made to Council in due course.

	 The clerk updated on progress in arranging events in 2024. Members asked questions and made a number of suggestions about the detailed arrangements, notably Involving a wider range of groups in the summer Saturdays – eg the scouts groups Extending the events markets throughout the town centre where there was demand from traders Involving community groups alongside the vegan market Sharing the distribution list for the event brochure to see if its circulation could be extended Encouraging regular buskers in the town centre on non event days Facilitating big screen events either in the town centre or Wicksteed Park
