What we are doing

Northamptonshire Highways will soon start reconstructing the footways along Pennine Way.

These works will be carried out in two phases with Phase 1 starting on Monday 27th September. This phase will include footways from property No.26 – No. 54 and from Chiltern Road – Wessex Close.

Phase 2 is still being finalised.

All the footways will be reconstructed. Vehicle crossings will be part of these works including new kerbs and edgings and, in some cases, widened at the entrances to properties to bring them in line with current highway standards. Tactile crossing will be installed at the junction with Chiltern Road. Verges will then be reinstated with top soil and grass seed.

Traffic Management

When programming works, we consider the impact on all network users and plan our works to minimise disruption as much as possible. Our works will mostly take place on the footways and verge, however there will be times where we will be required to create a “Priority” Traffic Management system when removing waste and delivering asphalt. This will mean there may be some delays. Please allow extra time for your journey.

Information for residents

Vehicle access and egress: We will maintain access for vehicles, however there are likely to be delays at times. There will be certain times when we ask that you do not park on a section of footway and short periods when there will be no access to drives. The onsite team will liaise with each household when this is required. Please speak to one of the site team on the day if you have any concerns about access.

Businesses: We ask that during the works people park legally on the nearest side street and walk to any businesses affected by the works.

Pedestrians: During the works, pedestrians will not be affected. Pedestrian diversion routes will be set out along the footway and clearly signed.

Cyclists: Access will be maintained.

Buses: We are not working near the bus stop and services should not be disrupted.

We have been working with the local authority and have agreed that parked vehicles that are preventing or hindering the works taking place, may be relocated to an adjacent street.

An approved contractor will carry this out and vehicles will be moved to a nearby street.

We understand that it may not be possible to move your vehicle at this time. If this is the case, please contact the Site Manager (details below) to discuss how we can help.

Please look out for the signs as shown on the right. These signs will be located on your street detailing the closure dates. We ask that you park away from our works area during these times.

Your assistance and cooperation is very much appreciated and this really helps us to complete the works to a high standard and efficiently.
